I AIMS & OBJECTIVES

EU-USR aims to create, though a bottomup approach that starts from some leading EU universities in the field of USR, a European model to enhance social responsibility of universities in a long-term perspective.

The key innovative contribution of the EU-USR project is lined to its holistic approach, its main challenge being to design a comprehensive strategy that meets the needs and problems of each EU region. It will detect good practices and attempt to design and test practical models for the development of local strategies for social action.

The main project objectives are:

- » University social responsibility (USR) definition in the member states.
- » USR good practices identification and analysis.
- » Open benchmarking system to map USR competencies and improve the response of HE institutions to the needs of their communities.
- » European model for the enhancement of USR, development and mainstreaming.
- » Creation of a European network on USR.

IEXPECTED IMPACT



- » Influence on the plans developed by participating universities fostering common policies through networking, and the impact on regional and national policies.
- » Transfer of a framework for all European universities and national governments.
- » Awareness of the university community as to its social dimension and the importance of a communitycontext.
- » Promote the interest of the university community on the Europe 2020 priorities by making socially active and responsible teachers and students.
- » Develop a system for identifying and evaluating best practices and promote USR policies.
